## **NEW PARKING LOT PROGRESSES AT REID PARK**

The new parking lot for the Zoo, Edith Ball Adaptive Recreation Center (ARC), and Reid Park is in progress. According to the Zoo's <u>July 25, 2023 project update</u>, "work continues on utilities as well as pouring of curb stops and light pole bases. There have been changes to the parking for Adaptive Recreation Center and along Lakeshore Lane during construction. Parks and Recreation, Reid Park Zoo, U of A Baseball, and the Adaptive Recreation Center representatives will continue to meet weekly as we ensure access is available to each facility throughout construction and to address any issues that arise quickly."

The Zoo's update advises that some parking spaces on Lakeshore Lane will be unavailable during construction. "These spaces will re-open again at the end of construction which is expected in November. Access to travel through Lakeshore Lane will continue to be available throughout construction."

According to the Zoo's initial announcement (see March 7, 2023 <u>bulletin with graphic</u>), "The new parking lot will be located where the maintenance yard for Tucson Parks and Recreation has been and is anticipated to be complete in fall 2023. The new lot does not use green space in the park and will increase the number of parking spaces available while approximately 95 trees will be planted as part of the project."
